Doug A. gave a brief demonstration of both High Dynamic Range photography (where you capture a wider range of brightness than normal) and Tone Mapping (where you compress this very wide range of brightness down to what a screen or printer can actually display). Some software treats both of these in one step, while others treat them separately. Doug compared two software programs, Skylum Aurora HDR and Photomatix.
